Re: Consultation - cosmetic medical and surgical procedures

The Consumers Health Forum of Australia (CHF) welcomes the opportunity to comment on the Draft Supplementary Guidelines to the Code 'Good Medical Practice: A Code of Conduct for Doctors in Australia'.

CHF is the national peak body representing the interests of approximately two million Australian healthcare consumers. CHF works to achieve safe, quality, timely healthcare for all Australians, supported by accessible health information and systems.

Safety and quality of health services is a particular concern in the area of cosmetic medical and surgical procedures.
