I wish to comment on the Professional Indemnity Insurance standard – "Employer Indemnified" I understand that as a locum, the GP who employs me is liable for my actions. I would like to know at which point does the employing GP cease to be liable, ie if the locum is negligent and in breach of his/her professional registration standards, or at some other arbitrary juncture which is not clear to me now. Does the limit of the employer's indemnification need to be specified for locum practitioners?

I have read my indemnity insurance policy and cannot see any reference to locum practitioners and employer indemnification limits.

I am yet to discuss this concern with my insurer. I intend to do so...
